Yandina showcases quaint heritage buildings set against the backdrop of picturesque landscapes, the town exudes a warm and welcoming culture and the historical charm endures through the preservation of original buildings down the heritage streetscape of Stevens Street.

The fertile lands around Yandina have been used for raising beef and dairy cattle, growing fruits, cultivating sugar cane, and farming ginger. Within this rich history, country town culture & beautiful natural landscapes, there are many hidden treasures to uncover and explore.

Come & discover the stunning countryside of the Yandina district, its history, characters, community & experiences.



Did you know Yandina is one of the oldest towns on the Sunshine Coast?

Yandina's name is of Aboriginal origin and means 'to go on foot' (yan, go; dinna, on foot). The land around Yandina was rich in Bunya Pines, an important food source for indigenous Australians.

The first Europeans to occupy 'Maroochie', later known as Yandina, were the Skyring brothers who applied for and were granted leases in 1853 for three cattle runs extending northward from the Maroochy and South Maroochy Rivers. The approach to Yandina over the James Low Bridge identifies a historic place dating from the days when the Brisbane to Gympie Road crossed by a ford in 1868. Timber getters were some of the earliest arrivals in the late 1860s. In later years the land was developed for farming crops such as arrowroot, sugar cane and ginger.

More recently a strong industrial economy has evolved alongside a newly cosmopolitan vibe. The authenticity of Yandina remains with many of the original families still living in and around the town.

Explore the region's natural wonders. Take a scenic drive or simply take it all in on foot. At Yandina you'll discover; waterfalls, swimming holes and picnic spots. Walk the Heritage Trail to catch a glimpse of how our pioneers lived. Or, if you are a nature lover take a trip to the Trail Walk and Bird Viewing Hide, kayak the Maroochy River, or go horse-riding or mountain biking on some of the best bike trails in Queensland. If you still have the energy, hike the iconic Mount Ninderry and take in the magnificent view stretching all the way from the mountains of the lush green Sunshine Coast hinterland all the way to the golden beaches of the coastline and everything in between.

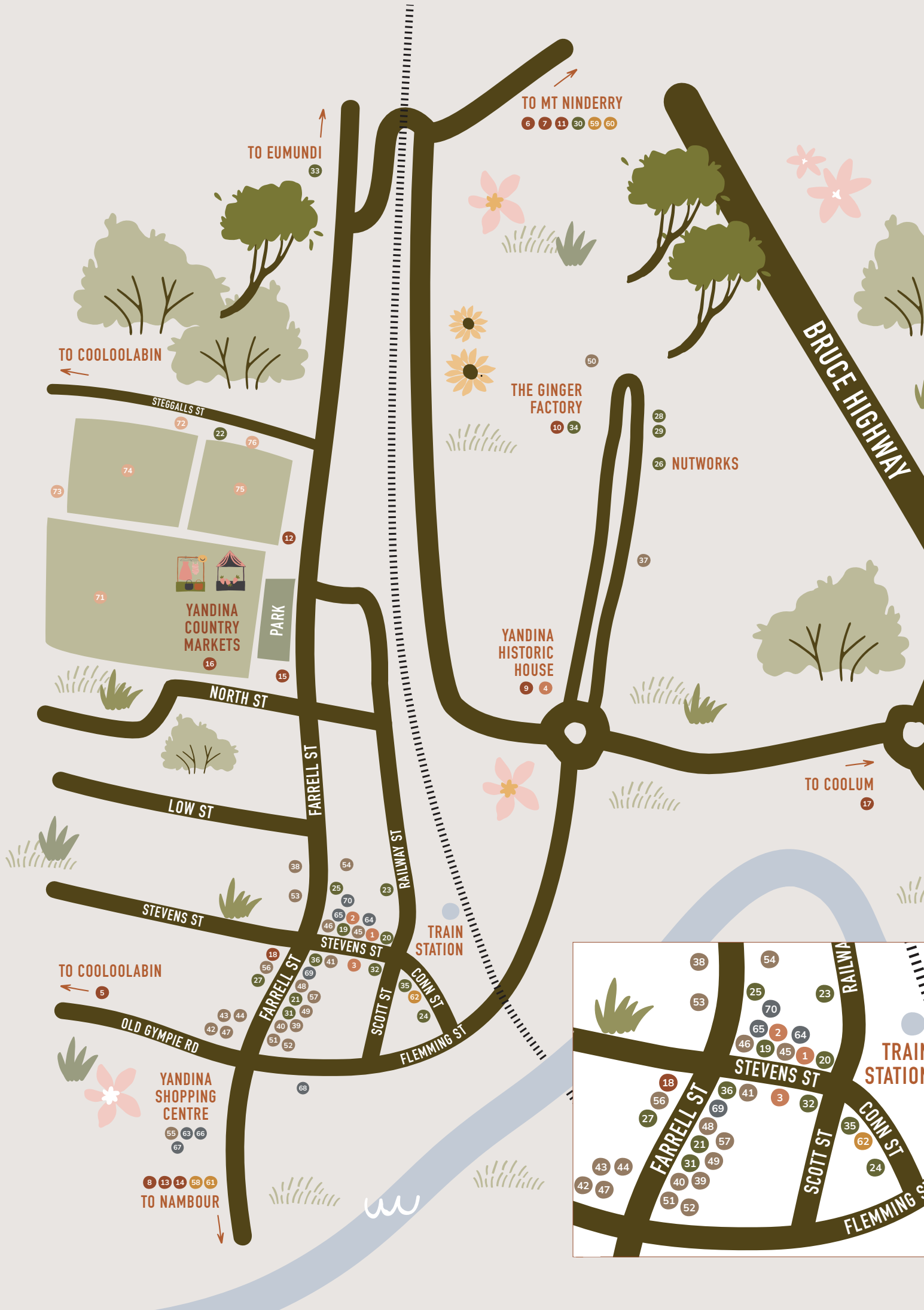
